ALARM SYSTEM SERVICE

The Municipal Housing Authority for the City of Yonkers ('PHA') will receive bids for the Service and Maintenance of their Alarm System on **Thursday June 2, 2011 until 3:00pm** at the office of the PHA, Augustine J. Shea Building, 1511 Central Park Avenue, Yonkers, New York 10710.

Sealed, separate proposals are invited for the work as follows: To Provide Service, Maintenance, Monitoring and Repairs to Existing Alarm Systems, Smoke Detectors and Install New or Additional alarms at all PHA Offices, Community Rooms and Common Areas as required. The proposals will **be reviewed, ranked and rated by the PHA and awarded to the most responsible bidders, which is most advantageous to the PHA.**

Bid Documents are on file at the office of the PHA, Augustine J. Shea Building, 1511 Central Park Avenue, Yonkers, New York and may be obtained **in person** with a **non-refundable** payment of **Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)** **Company Check** or **Money Order**, *only*. **Bidders must satisfy themselves by personal examination of the proposed work** and shall not, at any time after submission of Bid, dispute or complain nor assert that there was any misunderstanding in regard to the nature or amount of the work to be done.

Bid security in the form of a Money Order, Certified Check or Cashier's Check, made payable to The Municipal Housing Authority for the City of Yonkers or a satisfactory bid bond executed by the bidder and a surety company in an **amount not less than five percent (5%) of the dollar amount equal to one year of monitoring service.**

The PHA is an equal opportunity employer and reserves the right to reject any or all bids in the procurement procedure and if only one proposal is received, to return it unopened to the bidder or to waive any informalities. No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days subsequent to the opening of bids.
